No it's not a block of plywood!

This is **laminated wood** used in the boating industry for making full length keels in very big luxury boats. For our project purposes each rectangular lump of laminate consists of two blocks glued to be a single block .

This is a chance for all our members to showcase their talents and creative thinking by making absolutely anything from **ONE** of these blocks. About thirty-six of these blocks have been prepared for the project. Choose the one that takes your fancy.

Rules: Basically there are no rules for this project. You can add whatever you like to your creation. However, judges are likely to be more impressed by a turning outcome that features a good deal of the laminated wood.

Go on have a go! You can add colour, other woods, copper, tin, glass, leather, electronics, sound or even moving parts manual or battery motorised..... choices are wide, wide open and even the weird and whacky will be welcome.

Just make sure the laminated features somewhere in your project.

Block selection and your project starts during next week's sessions. Remember: ONE block per member. **Let your imagination run wild! Have fun! Clive**

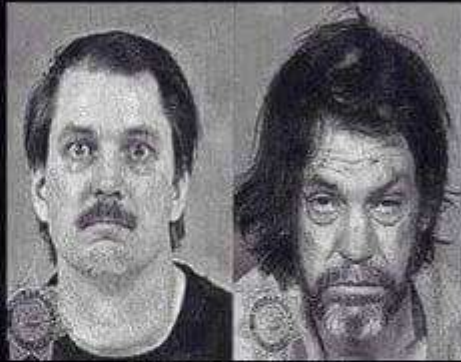
