Extravaganza Market day



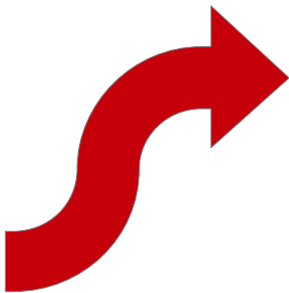
Hamilton Woodturners Club on display

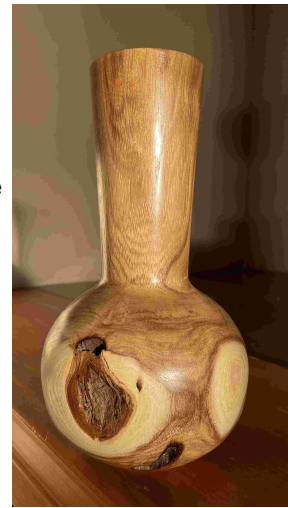
