COLIN's Natty Little Nick-Knack for pen making . An easy-peasy way to insert a slimline pen brass tube.



Fit a washer onto a six-inch nail. The diameter of the nail will fit inside a slimline brass tube.



Holding the nail apply glue to the brass tube. (no glue on fingers eh)



Now slide the gluey brass tube into the 7mm pre-drilled hole. (No mess Charlie eh)



....and there you have it! The gluedup brass has been inserted safely.

Make yourself one of these simple mess-saving gadgets. The washer acts as a bush on the six-inch nail and helps prevent the glue from getting into the brass tube.
