Within today's TT there's a few mini-box pictures that I hope will spur you on to greater heights and brilliant outcomes.


Remember keep those gouges super-ultra sharp for the best stria-free results.






COLIN WHITE's chestnut and Tassie Blackwood lidded pot is an eye-catcher with its novel shape.
